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SPACE POETRY ON THE ISS

During his stay on the ISS, Thomas Pesquet is set to perform, a highly original artistic experiment at the initiative of the Observatoire de l'Espace¹ called Télescope Intérieur (inner telescope), devised by American artist Eduardo Kac, inventor of the concept of 'holopoetry'². Once launched and free from the shackles of gravity, two shapes cut out of paper will form the three letters of the word 'moi. The text will become a mobile sculpture: depending on the angle, characters may or may not be visible as the shapes move, or people may see an abstract pattern or figurative representation. Télescope Intérieur will be an instrument of observation and poetic reflection to help us rethink our relationship with the world.
